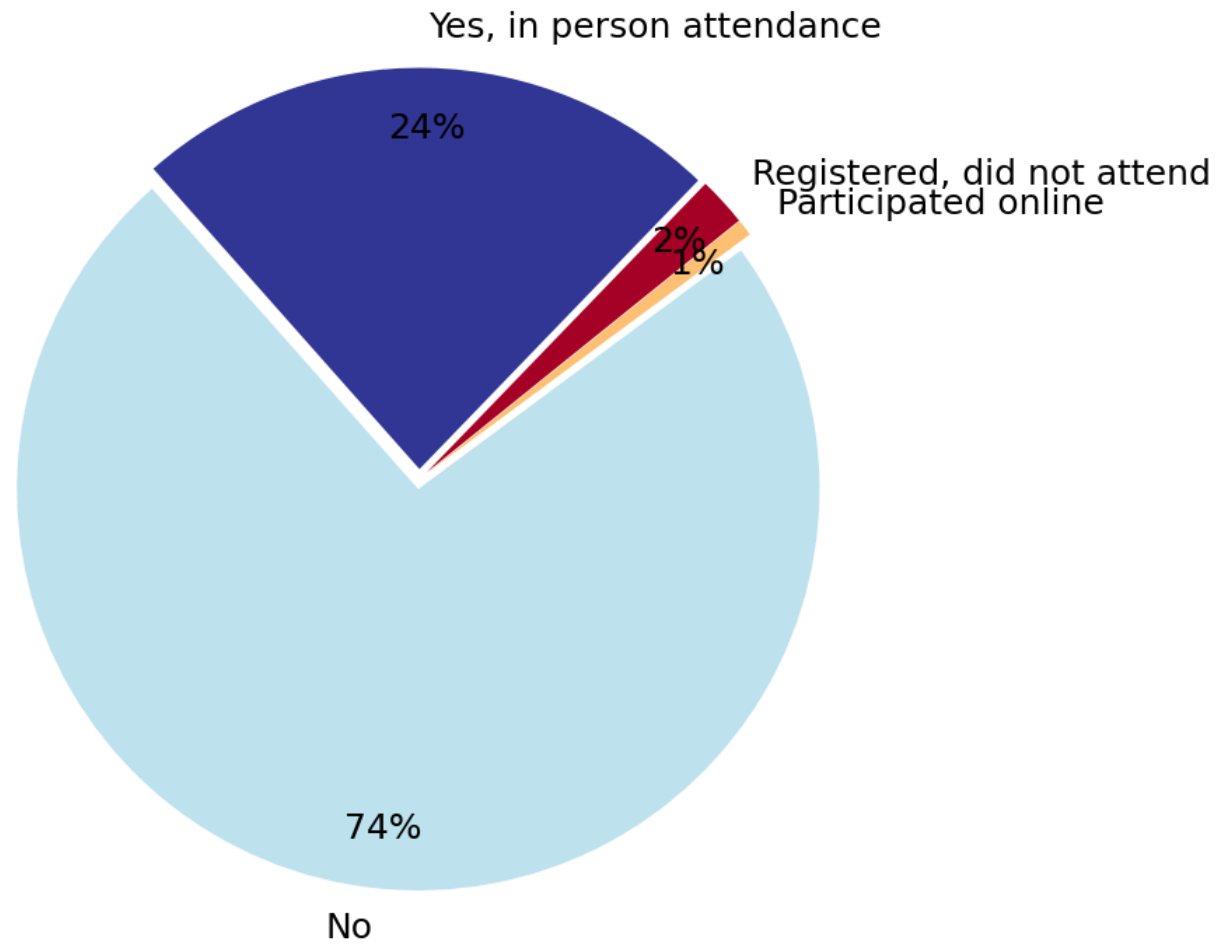

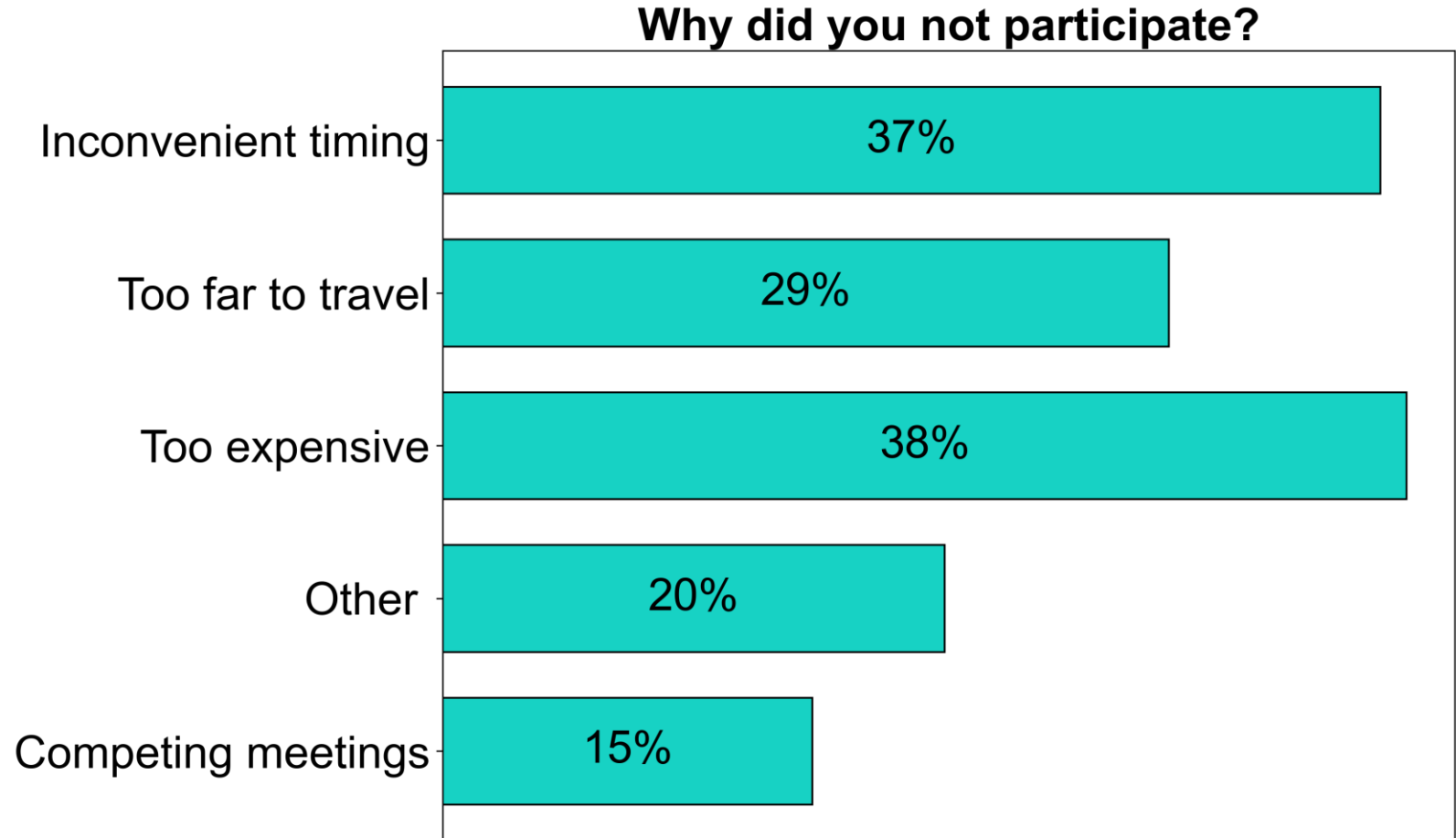

- Covid

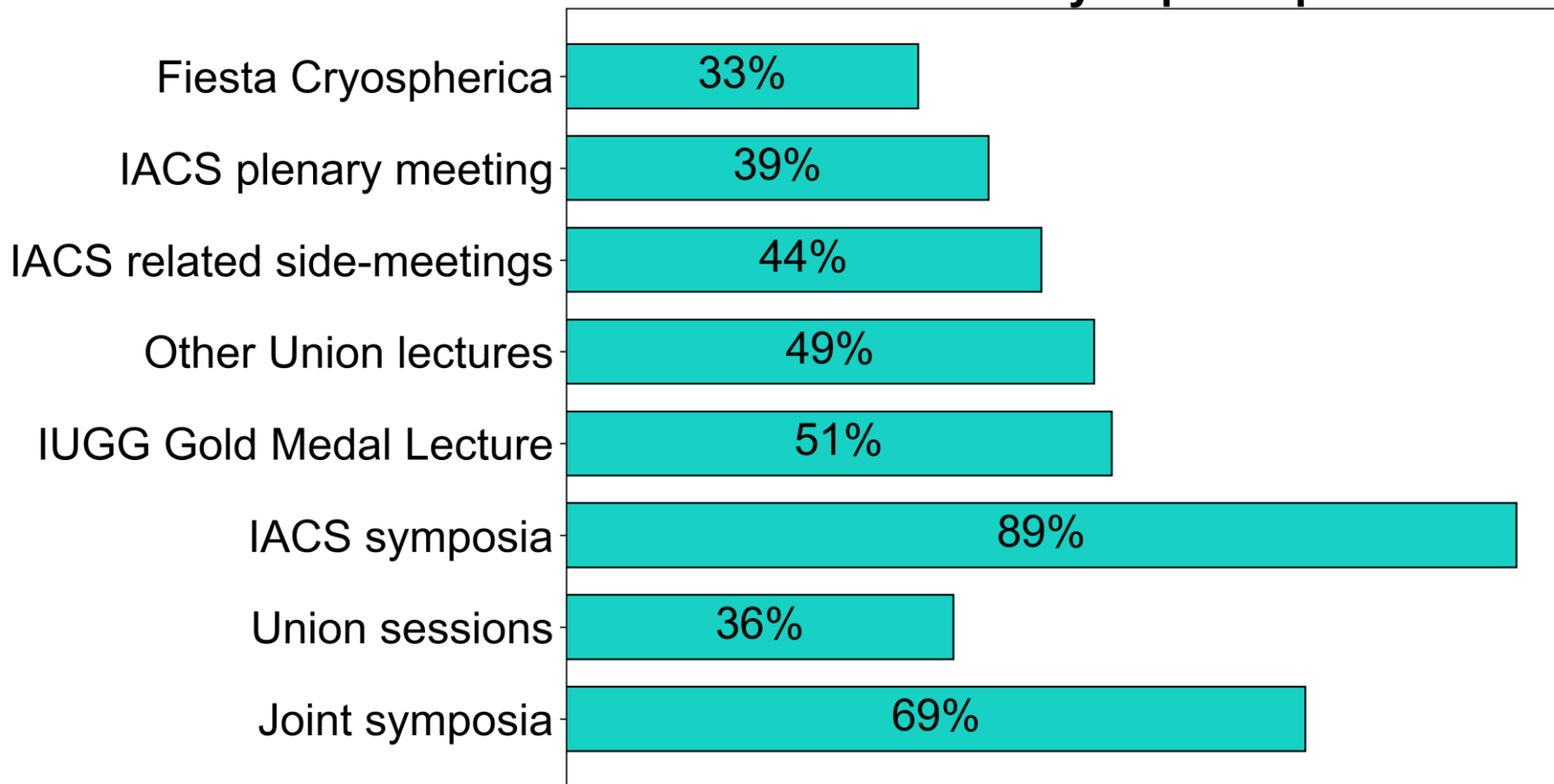

Summary of suggestions for coming assemblies

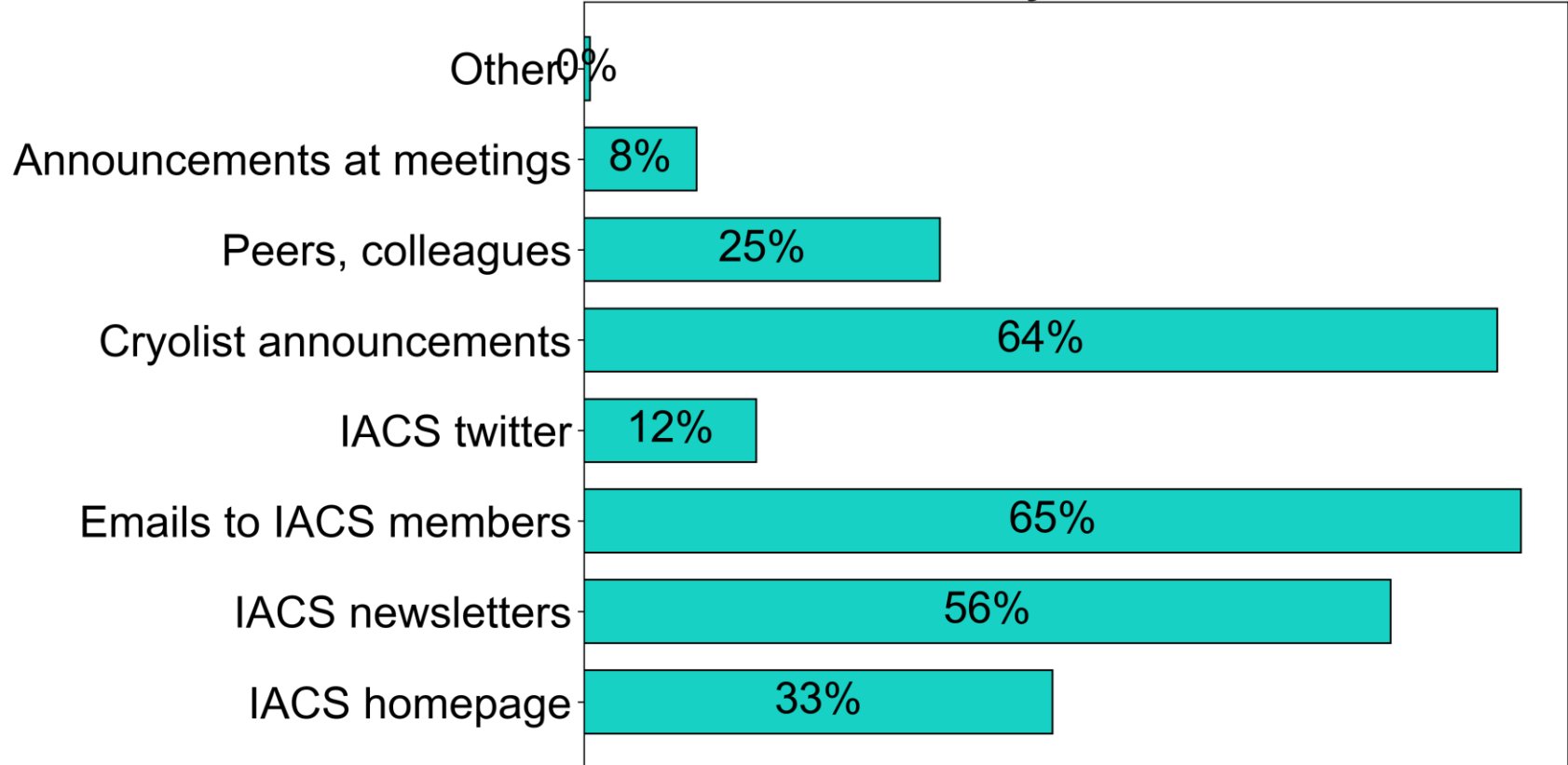
- Date: July is a holiday month, date conflicted with other conferences

Which of these channels do you use to be informed on IACS?

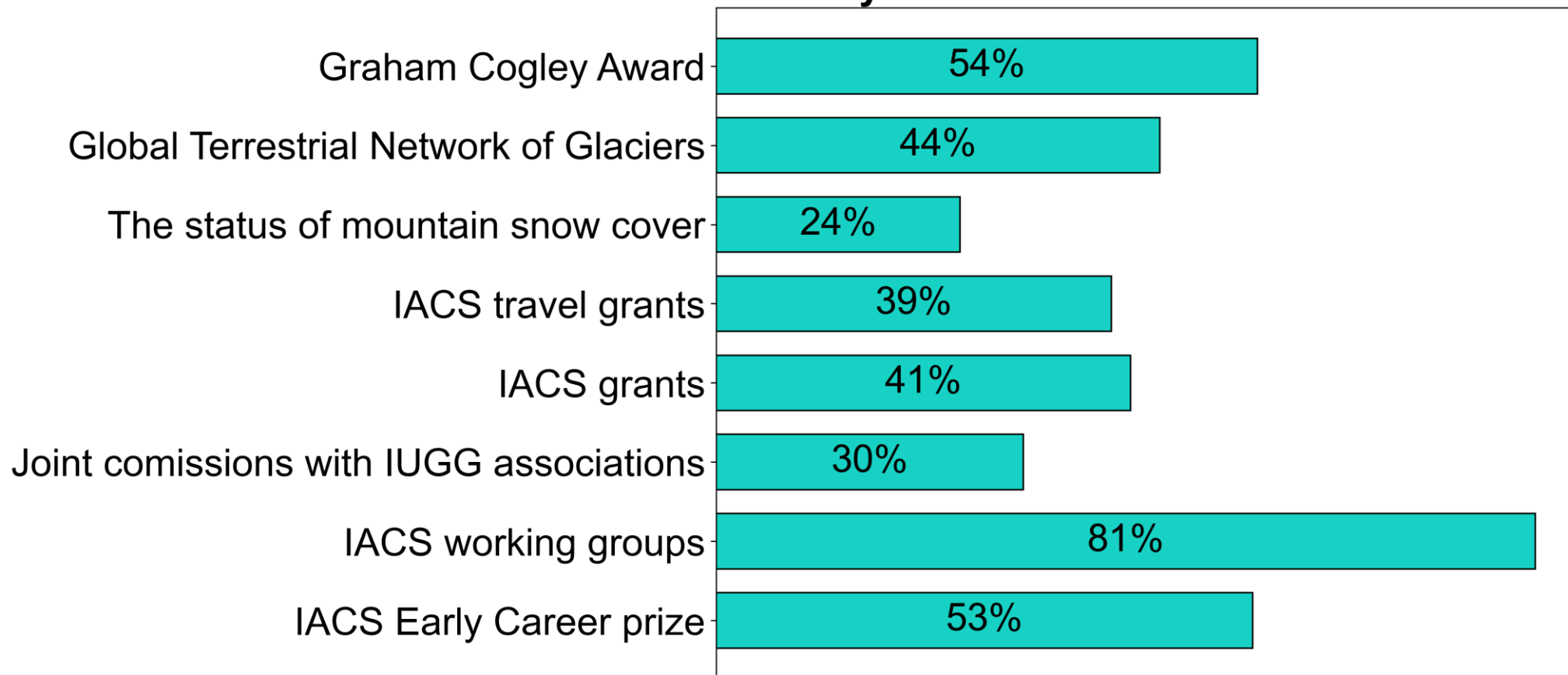

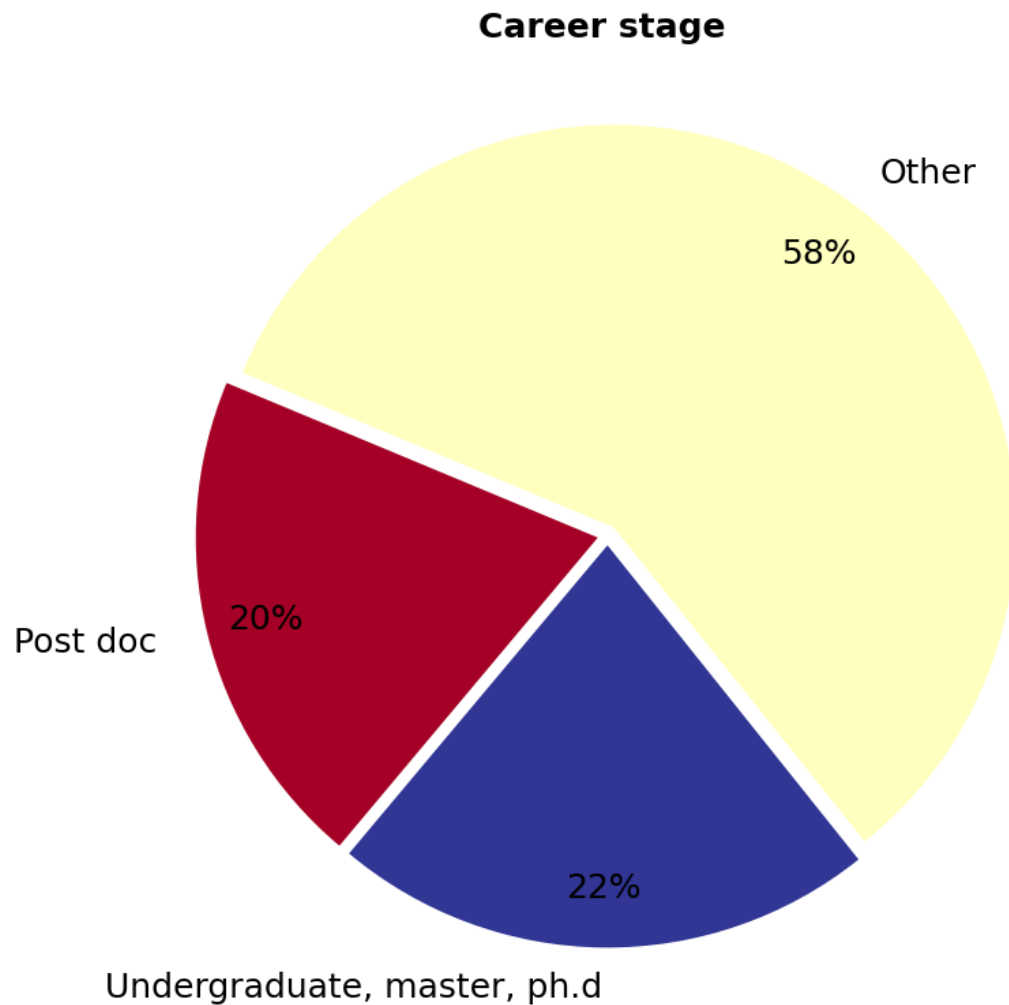

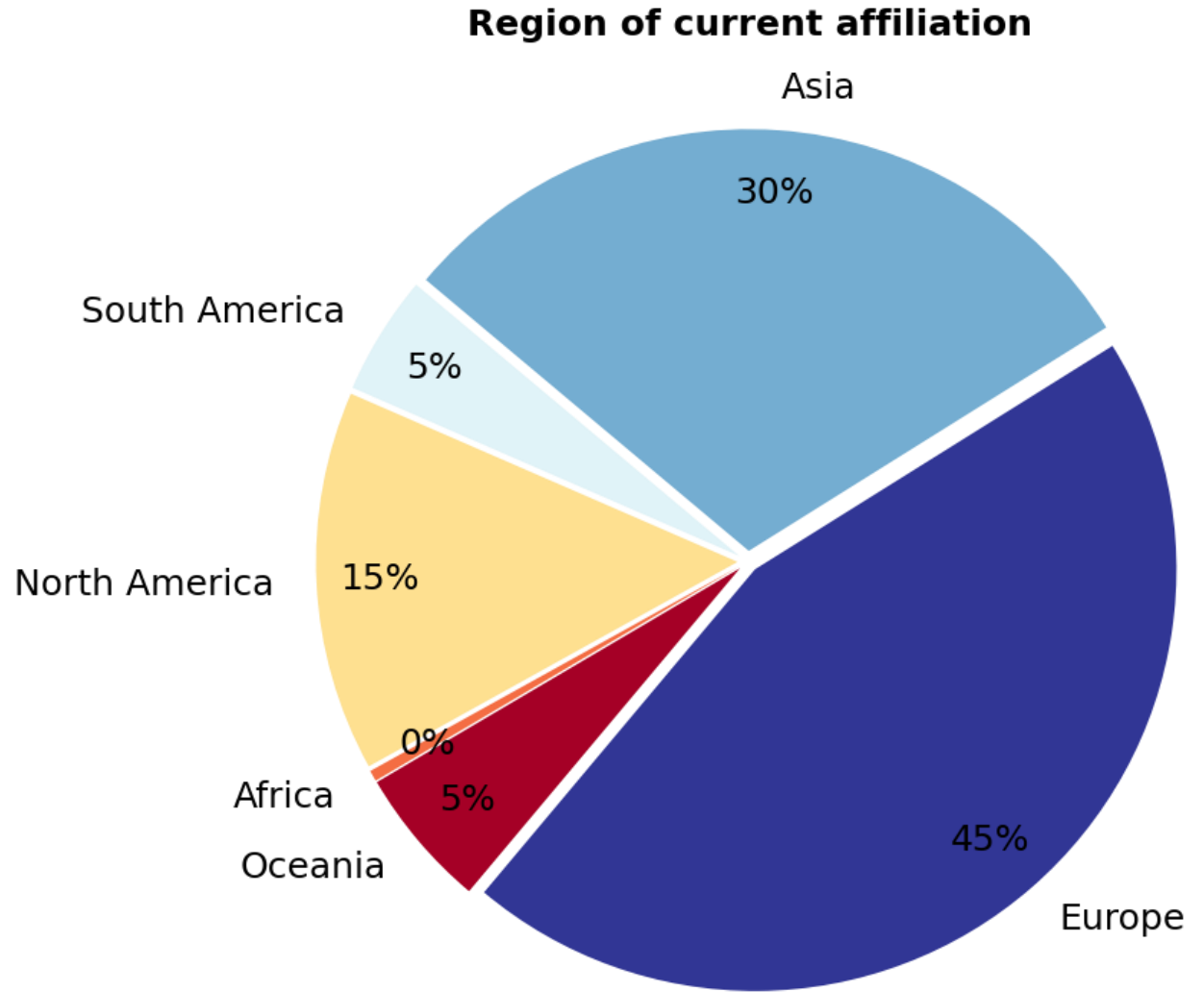

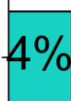
